Mr. FORD of Michigan (for himself and Mr. GOODLING) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Education and Labor

A BILL

To extend the operation of the migrant student record transfer system.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF RECORD TRANSFER SYSTEM.**

4 (a) PROGRAM EXTENSION.—Notwithstanding any
5 other provision of Federal law, the Secretary of Education
6 shall extend the contract for the operation of the migrant
7 student record transfer system under section
8 1203(a)(2)(A) of the Elementary and Secondary Edu-
9 cation Act of 1965 to operate such system until such time
10 as the Secretary of Education determines is necessary, but

1 shall not extend such contract beyond June 30, 1995,
2 without conducting a competition.

3 (b) PROGRAM MODIFICATION.—Major modification
4 of such system may be made only after consultation with
5 the Committee on Education and Labor of the House of
6 Representatives and the Committee on Labor and Human
7 Resources of the Senate.
