To amend the Agricultural Adjustment Act of 1938 to revise the reserve stock level for Burley tobacco.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REVISION OF RESERVE STOCK LEVEL FOR**

4 **BURLEY TOBACCO.**

5 (a) REVISION.—Section 301(b)(14)(D) of the Agri-
6 cultural Adjustment Act of 1938 (7 U.S.C.
7 1301(b)(14)(D)) is amended—

8 (1) in clause (i), by striking “50,000,000
9 pounds” and inserting “100,000,000 pounds”; and

1 (2) in clause (ii), by striking “15 percent” and
2 inserting “20 percent”.

3 (b) APPLICATION OF AMENDMENTS.—The amend-
4 ments made by subsection (a) shall apply with respect to
5 marketing years for Burley tobacco beginning after the
6 date of the enactment of this Act.
