## A BILL

To provide that certain service in the American Field Service ambulance corps shall be considered active duty for the purposes of all laws administered by the Secretary of Veterans Affairs.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION. 1. AMERICAN FIELD SERVICE.**

4       Section 401 of Public Law 95–202 (38 U.S.C. 106  
5       note) is amended—

6               (1) in subsection (b), by striking “subsection  
7       (a)” each place it appears and inserting “subsections  
8       (a) and (d)”;

1           (2) in subsection (c), by striking “subsection  
2           (a)” and inserting “subsections (a) and (d)”; and

3           (3) by adding at the end the following new sub-  
4           section:

5           (d) Notwithstanding any other provision of law,  
6           service rendered before August 15, 1945, by any  
7           person who was part of the enlisted wartime person-  
8           nel of the American Field Service ambulance corps  
9           and who reported for duty overseas during World  
10          War II, shall be considered active duty for the pur-  
11          poses of all laws administered by the Secretary of  
12          Veterans Affairs.”.
