## A BILL

To extend until January 1, 1998, certain previously existing temporary duty suspensions.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF DUTY SUSPENSIONS.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of  
5 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is  
6 amended by striking “12/31/92” in each of the following  
7 headings and inserting “12/31/97”:

8 (1) Heading 9902.30.19 (relating to 2-  
9 ethylanthraquinone).

1           (2) Heading 9902.30.79 (relating to rhodamine  
2       2C base).

3           (3) Heading 9902.32.06 (relating to acid black  
4       210 powder and presscake).

5           (4) Heading 9902.32.07 (relating to pigment  
6       red 178).

7           (5) Heading 9902.32.08 (relating to pigment  
8       red 149 dry and pigment red 149 presscake).

9           (6) Heading 9902.32.30 (relating to  
10      isoindolemine red pigment).

11 **SEC. 2. APPLICABILITY.**

12       (a) IN GENERAL.—The amendments made by section  
13 1 shall take effect on the 15th day after the date of the  
14 enactment of this Act.

15       (b) RETROACTIVE PROVISION.—Notwithstanding sec-  
16 tion 514 of the Tariff Act of 1930 or any other provision  
17 of law to the contrary, upon a request filed with the appro-  
18 priate customs officer before the 90th day after the date  
19 of the enactment of this Act, any entry or withdrawal from  
20 warehouse for consumption of goods to which any amend-  
21 ment made by section 1 applies and that was made—

22           (1) after December 31, 1992; and

23           (2) before the 15th day after the date of the en-  
24      actment of this Act;

1 and with respect to which there would have been no duty  
2 or a lower duty if such amendment had applied to such  
3 entry or withdrawal, shall be liquidated or reliquidated as  
4 though such entry or withdrawal had occurred on such  
5 15th day.
