## A BILL

To permit a State to provide disaster relief using amounts available to the State for a program or project if such amounts were specifically appropriated or otherwise made available to the State by a Federal statute, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. USE OF AMOUNTS TO SUPPLEMENT DISASTER**  
4 **RELIEF.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other provi-  
6 sion of law, any State which is eligible to receive disaster  
7 relief under the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and

1 Emergency Assistance Act may supplement such disaster  
2 relief using amounts available to the State for a program  
3 or project if such amounts were specifically appropriated  
4 or otherwise made available to the State by a Federal  
5 statute.

6 (b) LIMITATION.—A State may supplement disaster  
7 relief using amounts described in subsection (a) only if  
8 the purpose of such disaster relief is related to the purpose  
9 of the program or project for which the amounts were ap-  
10 propriated or otherwise made available to the State.

11 (c) APPLICABILITY.—Subsection (a) shall apply to  
12 amounts appropriated or otherwise made available to a  
13 State before, on, or after the date of the enactment of  
14 this Act.
