Mr. MARTINEZ introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

To amend the Immigration Reform and Control Act of 1986 to extend alien eligibility for educational assistance under the SLIAG program.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXTENDING ALIEN ELIGIBILITY FOR EDU-**
4 **CATIONAL ASSISTANCE UNDER THE SLIAG**
5 **PROGRAM.**

6 Section 204 of Immigration Reform and Control Act
7 of 1986 is amended—

8 (1) in subsection (c)(3)—

9 (A) by striking “and” at the end of sub-
10 paragraph (C),

1 (B) by striking the period at the end of
2 subparagraph (D) and inserting “; and”, and

3 (C) by adding at the end the following:

4 “(E) with respect to funds made available dur-
5 ing fiscal year 1994, providers should give priority
6 to those eligible legalized aliens who have not com-
7 pleted 40 hours of training programs designed to en-
8 able such aliens to attain citizenship skills described
9 in section 245A(b)(1)(D)(i) of the Immigration and
10 Nationality Act.”; and

11 (2) by inserting before the period at the end of
12 subsection (j)(4) the following: “, except that, with
13 respect to funding for the provision of educational
14 services described in subsection (c)(1)(C) during fis-
15 cal year 1994, such five-year limitation shall not
16 apply”.
