Mr. MONTGOMERY (by request) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Armed Services

A BILL

To provide eligibility for military commissary and exchange privileges and space-available transportation on military aircraft to certain former enlisted members of the Armed Forces discharged for disability.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That (a) the Secretary of Defense shall provide that veter-
4 ans described in subsection (b) shall be eligible for military
5 commissary and exchange privileges, and for space-avail-
6 able transportation on military aircraft, to the same extent
7 as retired members of the Armed Forces.

1 (b) Veterans referred to in subsection (a) are former
2 enlisted members of the Armed Forces (1) who were dis-
3 charged from active military service before October 1,
4 1949, for a service-connected disease or disability rated
5 by the Veterans' Administration as 30 percent or more
6 disabling, and (2) who retained an evaluation of having
7 a service-connected disability of 30 percent or more dis-
8 abling for a period of not less than 5 years from the date
9 of separation from active duty.
