Mr. MONTGOMERY (by request) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Armed Services

A BILL

To amend title 10, United States Code, to authorize veterans who are totally disabled as the result of a service-connected disability to travel on military aircraft in the same manner and to the same extent as retired members of the Armed Forces are entitled to travel on such aircraft.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That chapter 157 of title 10, United States Code, is
4 amended by adding at the end the following new section:

1 **“§ 2643. Travel privileges on military aircraft: totally**
2 **disabled veterans**

3 “(a) A veteran who is entitled to compensation from
4 the Department of Veterans Affairs for a service-con-
5 nected disability rated total in degree by the Secretary of
6 Veterans Affairs is entitled, in the same manner and to
7 the same extent as retired members of the armed forces,
8 to travel on a space-available basis on unscheduled mili-
9 tary flights within the continental United States and on
10 scheduled overseas flights operated by the Military Airlift
11 Command.

12 “(b) In this section, the term ‘veteran’ has the mean-
13 ing given that term in section 101(2) of title 38.”.

14 SEC. 2. The table of section at the beginning of chap-
15 ter 157 of title 10, United States Code, is amended by
16 adding at the end the following new item:

“2643. Travel privileges on military aircraft: totally disabled veterans.”.
