Mr. PALLONE introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Post Office and Civil Service

## A BILL

To designate “The Most Beautiful Lady in the World”, by Helmut Christopher Calabrese and Paul L. Calabrese, as the official anthem of the Statue of Liberty.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This legislation may be cited as the “Official Anthem  
5 of the Statue of Liberty”.

6 **SEC. 2. AN HONORED TRIBUTE.**

7 Whereas on the one hundredth anniversary of the  
8 dedication of the world’s most revered monument of free-  
9 dom, the Statue of Liberty was honored by a chorus of

1 schoolchildren singing “The Most Beautiful Lady in the  
2 World” written and composed by Helmut C. Calabrese and  
3 Paul L. Calabrese. This profound expression of emotion  
4 was an inspirational dedication to the Statue of Liberty’s  
5 long service as a beacon of hope and gateway of oppor-  
6 tunity.

7 **SEC. 3. INTENTION OF CONGRESS.**

8       It is the intent of the One Hundred Third Congress  
9 to memorialize “The Most Beautiful Lady in the World”  
10 and dedicate it as the official anthem of the Statue of Lib-  
11 erty. Helmut and Paul Calabrese’s song is a tribute to  
12 the Statue of Liberty and should be preserved for genera-  
13 tions to come.
