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## A BILL

For the relief of Kris Murty.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. RELOCATION EXPENSES FOR KRIS MURTY.**

4 For the purpose of receiving reimbursement for relo-  
5 cation expenses under sections 5724 and 5724a of title  
6 5, United States Code, Kris Murty of El Paso, Texas, an  
7 employee of the Department of the Army, is deemed to  
8 have been an employee transferred by the Department of

1 the Army from one official station to another for perma-  
2 nent duty when he relocated from Houston, Texas, to Fort  
3 Bliss, Texas, in February 1985.

4 **SEC. 2. LIMITATION ON AGENTS AND ATTORNEYS FEES.**

5 No amount exceeding 10 percent of a payment made  
6 pursuant to section 1 may be paid to or received by any  
7 agent or attorney in consideration for services rendered  
8 in connection with the payment. Any person who violates  
9 the provisions of this section shall be guilty of an infrac-  
10 tion and shall be subject to a fine in the amount provided  
11 under title 18, United States Code.
