## A BILL

For the relief of John Demjanjuk, Sr.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PAROLE.**

4 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the At-  
5 torney General shall parole into the United States, John  
6 Demjanjuk, Sr.

7 **SEC. 2. GRANT OF NATURALIZATION TO JOHN DEMJANJUK,**

8 **SR.**

9 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any requirement  
10 of the Immigration and Nationality Act or any other provi-  
11 sion of law, John Demjanjuk, Sr., shall be naturalized as  
12 a citizen of the United States upon the filing of the appro-

1 piate application and upon being administered the oath  
2 of renunciation and allegiance in an appropriate ceremony  
3 pursuant to section 337 of the Immigration and National-  
4 ity Act.

5 (b) DEADLINE FOR APPLICATION AND PAYMENT OF  
6 FEES.—Subsection (a) shall apply only if the application  
7 for naturalization is filed with appropriate fees within 1  
8 year after the date of the enactment of this Act.
