Mr. SYNAR (for himself and Mr. DURBIN) introduced the following bill; which
was referred to the Committee on Ways and Means

A BILL

To increase the fee for the enforcement of the Tea
Importation Act.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. FEE INCREASE.**

4 (a) AMENDMENTS TO ACT.—The Tea Importation
5 Act is amended by—

6 (1) striking out sections 11 and 12, and

7 (2) inserting the 4th undesignated paragraph
8 under the center heading “FOOD AND DRUG ADMIN-
9 ISTRATION” of title II of the Labor-Federal Security
10 Appropriation Act, 1942 (21 U.S.C. 46a) as a new
11 section 11 of such Act.

1 (b) AMENDMENT TO SECTION.—The section 11
2 added to the Tea Importation Act by subsection (a) is
3 amended to read as follows:

4 “SEC. 11. No tea or merchandise described as tea
5 shall be examined for importation into the United States
6 or released by the Collector of Customs under the Tea Im-
7 portation Act unless the importer or consignee of such tea
8 or merchandise has paid, before such examination, a fee
9 of 10 cents for each hundred weight or fraction thereof
10 of such tea or merchandise. Such fee shall be deposited
11 into the Treasury of the United States as miscellaneous
12 receipts.”.
