1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. 2-PHOSPHONOBUTANE-1,2,4-TRICARBOXYLIC**  
4 **ACID AND SODIUM SALTS.**

5 Subchapter II of chapter 99 of the Harmonized Tar-  
6 iff Schedule of the United States is amended by inserting  
7 in numerical sequence the following new headings:

**1 SEC. 2. APPLICABILITY.**

2       The amendment made by section 1 shall apply with  
3 respect to goods entered, or withdrawn from warehouse  
4 for consumption, on or after the 15th day after the date  
5 of the enactment of this Act.
