1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXPANSION OF SOUTHWESTERN PENNSYLVA-**

4 **NIA HERITAGE PRESERVATION COMMISSION.**

5 (a) FINDINGS.—Section 1 of Public Law 100–698
6 (102 Stat. 4618) is amended by striking out “9-county”
7 both places it appears and inserting in lieu thereof “11-
8 county”.

9 (b) ESTABLISHMENT.—Section 101 of such Act is
10 amended—

1 (1) in subsection (a)—

2 (A) by inserting “Greene,” after “Fayette”
3 and “Washington,” after “Somerset,” in the
4 matter preceding paragraph (1);

5 (B) by striking out “21 members” and in-
6 serting in lieu thereof “23 members” in the
7 matter preceding paragraph (1);

8 (C) by striking out “9” and inserting in
9 lieu thereof “11” in paragraph (2); and

10 (D) by inserting “Greene,” after “Fayette”
11 and “Washington,” after “Somerset,” in para-
12 graph (2);

13 (2) in subsection (b), by striking out “9” and
14 inserting in lieu thereof “11”.
