Mr. GALLEGLY introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

To prohibit the admission to the United States as refugees of individuals who have served in the armed forces of Iraq during the Persian Gulf conflict.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PROHIBITION OF ADMISSION TO THE UNITED**
4 **STATES AS REFUGEES OF INDIVIDUALS WHO**
5 **HAVE SERVED IN THE ARMED FORCES OF**
6 **IRAQ DURING THE PERSIAN GULF CONFLICT.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other provi-
8 sion of law, individuals who have served in the armed
9 forces of Iraq during the Persian Gulf conflict may not

1 be admitted to the United States as refugees under the
2 Immigration and Nationality Act.

3 (b) PERSIAN GULF CONFLICT DEFINED.—For pur-
4 poses of this section, the term “Persian Gulf conflict”
5 means the period beginning on August 2, 1990, and end-
6 ing on February 27, 1991.
