3 **SECTION 1. ELIMINATION OF DISPARITY BETWEEN CIVIL-**
4 **IAN AND MILITARY RETIREE COST-OF-LIVING**
5 **ADJUSTMENTS.**

6 Section 1401a(b)(6) of title 10, United States Code
7 (as added by section 2001 of the Omnibus Budget Rec-

1 onciliation Act of 1993 (Public Law 103–66)), is amend-
2 ed—

3 (1) in the paragraph heading, by striking out
4 “THROUGH 1998.—” and inserting in lieu thereof
5 “THROUGH 1996.—”;

6 (2) in subparagraph (A)—

7 (A) by striking out the subparagraph head-
8 ing and inserting in lieu thereof “FISCAL YEARS
9 1994 THROUGH 1996.—”;

10 (B) by striking out “December 1, 1993,”
11 and inserting in lieu thereof “December 1 of
12 1993, 1994, or 1995,”; and

13 (C) by striking out “March 1994” and in-
14 serting in lieu thereof “March of the following
15 year”;

16 (3) by striking out subparagraph (B); and

17 (4) by redesignating subparagraph (C) as sub-
18 paragraph (B), and in that subparagraph by striking
19 out “Subparagraphs (A) and (B) do” and inserting
20 in lieu thereof “Subparagraph (A) does”.
