Mr. PORTER introduced the following bill; which was referred to the

A BILL

To provide that the flag of the United States should be displayed at half-staff on all Government buildings on Peace Officers Memorial Day, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DISPLAY OF FLAGS AT HALF STAFF.**

4 (a) The first section of Public Law 87-726 (36
5 U.S.C. 167) is amended—

6 (1) by striking “(2)” and inserting “(3)”;

7 (2) by inserting after clause (1) the following
8 new clause: “(2) directing the officials of the Gov-
9 ernment to display at half-staff the flag of the Unit-

1 ed States on all Government buildings on such day,
2 as provided by section 3(m) of the Act of June 22,
3 1942 (Chapter 435; 56 Stat. 377; 36 U.S.C. 175),”;

4 (3) by striking “(3)” and inserting “(4)”; and

5 (4) by inserting in paragraph (4) “, including
6 the display at half-staff of the flag of the United
7 States” after “activities”.

8 (b) Section 3(m) of the Act of June 22, 1942 (Chap-
9 ter 435; 56 Stat. 377; 36 U.S.C. 175) is amended by in-
10 sserting “The flag shall be flown at half-staff on Peace Of-
11 ficers Memorial Day.” after “a Member of Congress.”.
