## A BILL

To amend title 38, United States Code, to permit retired members of the Armed Forces who have service-connected disabilities to receive compensation from the Department of Veterans Affairs concurrently with retired pay, without deduction from either.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*  
3       That section 5304(a)(1) of title 38, United States Code,  
4       is amended by adding at the end thereof the following:  
5       “Notwithstanding the preceding sentence, emergency offi-  
6       cers’, regular, or reserve retirement pay may be paid to  
7       any veteran concurrently with compensation for any serv-

1 ice-connected disability, without deduction from either the  
2 retirement pay or the compensation; however, nothing in  
3 this sentence shall permit payment of retirement pay and  
4 of compensation based upon the same disability.”.
