## A BILL

To amend the Congressional Budget Act of 1974 to provide for allocations of authorizations of budget authority to authorizing committees of the House of Representatives and the Senate.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ALLOCATIONS OF AUTHORIZATIONS TO COM-**  
4 **MITTEES.**

5 (a) ALLOCATIONS OF AUTHORIZATION LEVELS TO  
6 HOUSE COMMITTEES.—

7 (1) Section 302(a)(1) of the Congressional  
8 Budget Act of 1974 is amended by adding at the

1 end the following new sentence: “That joint explana-  
2 tory statement shall also include, for each fiscal year  
3 covered by that concurrent resolution, an allocation  
4 of appropriate levels of total authorizations of budg-  
5 et authority for each committee of the House of  
6 Representatives which has jurisdiction over laws,  
7 bills, and resolutions providing such authorizations  
8 of new budget authority .”.

9 (2) Section 602(a)(1)(A) of the Congressional  
10 Budget Act of 1974 is amended by adding at the  
11 end the following new sentence: “That joint explana-  
12 tory statement shall also include, for each fiscal year  
13 covered by that concurrent resolution, an allocation  
14 of appropriate levels of total authorizations of budg-  
15 et authority for each committee of the House of  
16 Representatives which has jurisdiction over laws,  
17 bills, and resolutions providing such authorizations  
18 of new budget authority .”.

19 (b) ALLOCATIONS OF AUTHORIZATION LEVELS TO  
20 SENATE COMMITTEES.—

21 (1) Section 302(a)(2) of the Congressional  
22 Budget Act of 1974 is amended by adding at the  
23 end the following new sentence: “That joint explana-  
24 tory statement shall also include, for each fiscal year  
25 covered by that concurrent resolution, an allocation

1 of appropriate levels of total authorizations of budg-  
2 et authority for each committee of the Senate which  
3 has jurisdiction over laws, bills, and resolutions pro-  
4 viding such authorizations of new budget author-  
5 ity.”.

6 (2) Section 602(a)(2) of the Congressional  
7 Budget Act of 1974 is amended by adding at the  
8 end the following new sentence: “That joint explana-  
9 tory statement shall also include, for each fiscal year  
10 covered by that concurrent resolution, an allocation  
11 of appropriate levels of total authorizations of budg-  
12 et authority for each committee of the Senate which  
13 has jurisdiction over laws, bills, and resolutions pro-  
14 viding such authorizations of new budget author-  
15 ity.”.

16 **SEC. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

17 The amendments made by this Act shall be effective  
18 for fiscal year 1995 and subsequent fiscal years.
