A BILL

To amend the Public Health Service Act to provide for research on the effects that environmental factors have on women's health.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Women’s Health Envi-
3 ronmental Factors Research Act of 1993”.

4 **SEC. 2. RESEARCH ON EFFECT OF ENVIRONMENTAL FAC-**
5 **TORS ON WOMEN’S HEALTH.**

6 Subpart 12 of part C of title IV of the Public Health
7 Service Act (42 U.S.C. 285), as amended by section 1301
8 of Public Law 103–43 (107 Stat. 169), is amended by
9 adding at the end the following section:

10 “EFFECT OF ENVIRONMENTAL FACTORS ON WOMEN’S
11 HEALTH

12 “SEC. 463B. (a) The Director of the Institute shall
13 carry out research on the effects that environmental fac-
14 tors have on women’s health conditions (as defined in sec-
15 tion 486), including the effect of such factors on breast
16 cancer, immune dysfunction, and estrogen-like compounds
17 (and related compounds).

18 “(b) For the purpose of carrying out subsection (a),
19 there are authorized to be appropriated \$30,000,000 for
20 fiscal year 1994, and such sums as may be necessary for
21 each of the fiscal years 1995 and 1996. Such authoriza-
22 tion is in addition to any other authorization of appropria-
23 tions that is established with respect to such purpose.”.
