## A BILL

To suspend until January 1, 1996, the duty on continuous oxidized polyacrylonitrile fiber tow.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. TEMPORARY DUTY SUSPENSION.**

4 Subchapter II of chapter 99 of the Harmonized Tar-  
5 iff Schedule of the United States is amended by inserting

6 in numerical sequence the following new heading:

“	9902.55.01	Continuous oxidized polyacrylo-nitrile fiber tow, total tow measurement of which is 15000 decitex or greater (provided for in sub-heading 5501.90.00) .....	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/95	”.

3 spect to articles entered, or withdrawn from warehouse for
