A BILL

To amend the Thomas Jefferson Commemoration Commission Act to extend the deadlines for reports.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REPORTS FROM THE COMMISSION.**

4 Section 9 of the Thomas Jefferson Commemoration
5 Commission Act (Public Law 102-343; 106 Stat. 915) is
6 amended—

7 (1) in subsection (a) by striking “December 31,
8 1992” and inserting “March 15, 1994”; and

9 (2) in subsection (b) by striking “December 31,
10 1993” and inserting “December 31, 1994”.

1 **SEC. 2. AUDIT OF FINANCIAL TRANSACTIONS.**

2 Section 10(b) of the Thomas Jefferson Commemora-
3 tion Commission Act (Public Law 102-343; 106 Stat.
4 915) is amended—

5 (1) by striking “December 31, 1992” each
6 place it appears and inserting “March 15, 1994”;

7 (2) by striking “March 4, 1994” and inserting
8 “March 3, 1995”; and

9 (3) by striking “1993” and inserting “1994”.

10 **SEC. 3. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

11 Section 12 of the Thomas Jefferson Commemoration
12 Commission Act (Public Law 102-343; 106 Stat. 915) is
13 amended by striking “and \$62,500 for fiscal year 1994”
14 and inserting “, \$150,000 for fiscal year 1994, and
15 \$62,500 for fiscal year 1995”.
