Mr. QUILLEN introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Post Office and Civil Service

A BILL

To amend title 39 of the United States Code to provide for door delivery of mail to the physically handicapped, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Mail Delivery to Phys-
5 ically Handicapped Act of 1993”.

6 **SEC. 2. DOOR DELIVERY TO THE PHYSICALLY HANDI-**
7 **CAPPED.**

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter IV of chapter 36 of
9 title 39, United States Code, is amended by inserting after
10 section 3662 the following new section:

1 **“§ 3663. Door delivery of mail to the physically handi-**
2 **capped**

3 “(a) Door delivery of mail shall be provided by the
4 Postal Service to any resident whose application for door
5 delivery of mail is approved by the Postal Service under
6 this section.

7 “(b)(1) Any resident may file with the Postal Service,
8 in such form and such manner as shall be prescribed by
9 the Postal Service by regulation, an application for door
10 delivery of mail under this section.

11 “(2) Any such application shall be approved by the
12 Postal Service if the application includes a certificate of
13 a licensed physician, in a form which shall be prescribed
14 by the Postal Service by regulation, stating that the physi-
15 cian has conducted a medical examination of the resident
16 and that the examination revealed that the resident is
17 physically handicapped to the extent that delivery of mail
18 to such resident other than by door delivery would impose
19 an immediate or potential medical or physical hardship on
20 such resident.

21 “(c) Door delivery of mail to a resident shall begin
22 immediately upon approval by the Postal Service of the
23 application by that resident for door delivery of mail under
24 this section.

25 “(d) The Postal Service shall prescribe regulations to
26 carry out the provisions of this section.”.

1 (b) TABLE OF SECTIONS.—The table of sections for
2 chapter 36 of title 39, United States Code, is amended
3 by inserting after the item relating to section 3662 the
4 following new item:

“3663. Door delivery of mail to the physically handicapped.”.
