## A BILL

To extend retroactively until January 1, 1996, the prior suspension of duty on amiloride hydrochloride.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SUSPENSION OF DUTY AMILORIDE HYDRO-**  
4 **CHLORIDE.**

5 Heading 9902.30.88 of the Harmonized Tariff  
6 Schedule of the United States is amended by striking out  
7 “12/31/92” and inserting “12/31/95”.

8 **SEC. 2. APPLICABILITY.**

9 (a) IN GENERAL.—The amendment made by section  
10 1 applies with respect to goods entered, or withdrawn from

1 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after  
2 the date of the enactment of this Act.

3 (b) RETROACTIVE PROVISION.—Notwithstanding sec-  
4 tion 514 of the Tariff Act of 1930 or any other provision  
5 of law, upon proper request filed with the appropriate cus-  
6 toms officer within 180 days after the 15th day after the  
7 date of the enactment of this Act, any entry or withdrawal  
8 from warehouse—

9 (1) that was made after December 31, 1992,  
10 and before such 15th day; and

11 (2) with respect to which there would have been  
12 no duty if the amendment made by section 1 applied  
13 to such entry or withdrawal;  
14 shall be liquidated or reliquidated as though such amend-  
15 ment applied to such entry or withdrawal.
