3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Public Safety Officers’
5 Benefits Fairness Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. BENEFITS FOR PERSONNEL IN CORRECTIONAL**
7 **FACILITIES.**

8 Section 1204(5) of the Omnibus Crime Control and
9 Safe Streets Act of 1968 is amended—

1 (1) by striking the comma after “corrections”;

3 (2) by inserting in lieu thereof “(including per-

4 sonnel in correctional facilities),”.
