Mr. NADLER introduced the following bill; which was referred jointly to the Committees on Education and Labor and Energy and Commerce

A BILL

To amend the Asbestos School Hazard Abatement Act of 1984 and title II of the Toxic Substances Control Act to expand the coverage of those Acts to include Head Start Programs, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Head Start Safety
5 Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. EXPANSION OF COVERAGE OF ASHAA.**

7 Section 511 of title V of the Education for Economic
8 Security Act (the Asbestos School Hazard Abatement Act

1 of 1984) (20 U.S.C.4011 and following) is amended as
2 follows:

3 (1) In paragraph (4) strike “and” at the end of
4 subparagraph (A), strike the period at the end of
5 subparagraph (B) and insert “; and” and add the
6 following at the end thereof:

7 “(C) any Head Start Agency des-
8 ignated under the Head Start Act (42
9 U.S.C. 9831 and following).”

10 (2) In paragraph (6) strike “and” at the end of
11 subparagraph (C), strike the period at the end of
12 subparagraph (D) and insert “; and” and add the
13 following at the end thereof:

14 “(E) any facility used for a Head
15 Start Program assisted under the Head
16 Start Act (42 U.S.C. 9831 and follow-
17 ing).”

18 **SEC. 3. EXPANSION OF COVERAGE OF TOXIC SUBSTANCES**

19 **CONTROL ACT**

20 (a) HEAD START PROGRAMS.—Section 202 of the
21 Toxic Substances Control Act is amended as follows:

22 (1) In paragraph (7) strike “and” at the end of
23 subparagraph (B), strike the period at the end of
24 subparagraph (C) and insert “; and” and add the
25 following at the end thereof:

1 “(D) any Head Start Agency des-
2 ignated under the Head Start Act (42
3 U.S.C. 9831 and following).”

4 (2) In paragraph (13) strike “and” at the end
5 of subparagraph (C), strike the period at the end of
6 subparagraph (D) and insert “; and” and add the
7 following at the end thereof:

8 “(E) any facility used for a Head
9 Start Program assisted under the Head
10 Start Act (42 U.S.C. 9831 and follow-
11 ing).”.

12 (b) EFFECTIVE DATES.—(1) Title II of the Toxic
13 Substances Control Act is amended by adding the follow-
14 ing new section at the end thereof:

15 **“SEC. 217. EFFECTIVE DATE FOR HEAD START PROGRAMS.**

16 “*In the case of any local educational agency which*
17 *is a Head Start Agency referred to in section 202(7)(D),*
18 *for purposes of applying the provisions of this title applica-*
19 *ble to school buildings described in section 202(13)(E),*
20 *the references in this title to the date of enactment of this*
21 *title shall be treated as references to the date of the enact-*
22 *ment of this section.”.*

23 (2) The table of contents for such title is amended
24 by adding the following new section at the end thereof:

“Sec. 217. Effective date for head start programs.”.

1 (c) REGULATIONS.—Within 180 days after the enact-
2 ment of this Act, the Administrator shall amend the regu-
3 lations promulgated under title II of the Toxic Substances
4 Control Act to reflect the amendments made by subsection
5 (a) of this section.
