A BILL

To prohibit the imposition of additional charges or fees for attendance at the United States Military Academy, the United States Naval Academy, the United States Air Force Academy, the United States Coast Guard Academy, and the United States Merchant Marine Academy.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. PROHIBITION ON IMPOSITION OF ADDITIONAL**
2 **CHARGES OR FEES FOR NATIONAL DEFENSE**
3 **ACADEMY ATTENDANCE.**

4 (a) PROHIBITION.—Except as provided in subsection
5 (b), no charge or fee for tuition, room, or board for attend-
6 ance at a national defense academy may be imposed unless
7 the charge or fee is specifically authorized by a law en-
8 acted after the date of the enactment of this Act.

9 (b) EXCEPTION.—The prohibition specified in sub-
10 section (a) shall not apply with respect to any item or serv-
11 ice provided to cadets or midshipmen at a national defense
12 academy for which a charge or fee is imposed as of the
13 date of the enactment of this Act. The Secretary of De-
14 fense or the Secretary of Transportation, as the case shall
15 be, shall notify the Congress of any change made by a
16 national defense academy in the amount of a charge or
17 fee authorized under this subsection.

18 (c) NATIONAL DEFENSE ACADEMY DEFINED.—For
19 purposes of this section, the term “national defense acad-
20 emy” means any of the following:

- 21 (1) The United States Military Academy.
- 22 (2) The United States Naval Academy.
- 23 (3) The United States Air Force Academy.
- 24 (4) The United States Coast Guard Academy.
- 25 (5) The United States Merchant Marine Acad-
26 emy.
