Resolved, That the Senate agree to the amendment of the House of Representatives to the amendment of the Senate to the bill (H.R. 3345) entitled “An Act to provide temporary authority to Government agencies relating to voluntary separation incentive payments, and for other purposes”, with the following

1 **(1)**Page 16, after line 9 of the House engrossed amend-
2 ment to the Senate engrossed amendment, insert:

3 ***SEC. 6. CREATION OF VIOLENT CRIME REDUCTION TRUST***

4 ***FUND.***

5 *(a) VIOLENT CRIME REDUCTION TRUST FUND.—There*
6 *is established a separate account in the Treasury, known*
7 *as the “Violent Crime Reduction Trust Fund”, into which*
8 *shall be deposited deficit reduction (as defined in subsection*
9 *(b) of this section) achieved by the preceding section.*

10 *“(b) On the first day of the following fiscal years (or*
11 *as soon thereafter as possible for fiscal year 1994), the fol-*
12 *lowing amounts shall be transferred from the general fund*
13 *to the Violent Crime Reduction Trust Fund—*

- 1 (1) for fiscal year 1994, \$720,000,000;
2 (2) for fiscal year 1995, \$2,423,000,000;
3 (3) for fiscal year 1996, \$4,267,000,000;
4 (4) for fiscal year 1997, \$6,313,000,000; and
5 (5) for fiscal year 1998, \$8,545,000,000.

6 (c) Notwithstanding any other provision of law—

7 (1) the amounts in the Violent Crime Reduction
8 Trust Fund may be appropriated exclusively for the
9 purposes authorized in the Violent Crime Control and
10 Law Enforcement Act of 1993;

11 (2) the amounts in the Violent Crime Reduction
12 Trust Fund and appropriations under paragraph (1)
13 of this section shall be excluded from, and shall not
14 be taken into account for purposes of, any budget en-
15 forcement procedures under the Congressional Budget
16 Act of 1974 or the Balanced Budget and Emergency
17 Deficit Control Act of 1985; and

18 (3) for purposes of this subsection, “appropria-
19 tions under paragraph (1)” mean amounts of budget
20 authority not to exceed the balances of the Violent
21 Crime Reduction Trust Fund and amounts of outlays
22 that flow from budget authority actually appro-
23 priated.

24 (b) LISTING OF THE VIOLENT CRIME REDUCTION
25 TRUST FUND AMONG GOVERNMENT TRUST FUNDS.—Sec-

1 *tion 1321(a) of title 31, United States Code, is amended*
2 *by inserting at the end thereof the following new paragraph:*

3 *“(91) Violent Crime Reduction Trust Fund.”.*

4 *(c) REQUIREMENT FOR THE PRESIDENT TO REPORT*
5 *ANNUALLY ON THE STATUS OF THE ACCOUNT.—Section*
6 *1105(a) of title 31, United States Code, is amended by add-*
7 *ing at the end thereof:*

8 *“(29) information about the Violent Crime Re-*
9 *duction Trust Fund, including a separate statement*
10 *of amounts in that Trust Fund.*

11 *“(30) an analysis displaying by agency proposed*
12 *reductions in full-time equivalent positions compared*
13 *to the current year’s level in order to comply with sec-*
14 *tion 1352 of the Violent Crime Control and Law En-*
15 *forcement Act of 1993.”.*

16 **SEC. 7. CONFORMING REDUCTION IN DISCRETIONARY**
17 **SPENDING LIMITS.**

18 *The Director of the Office of Management and Budget*
19 *shall, upon enactment of this Act, reduce the discretionary*
20 *spending limits set forth in section 601(a)(2) of the Con-*
21 *gressional Budget Act of 1974 for fiscal years 1994 through*
22 *1998 as follows:*

23 *(1) for fiscal year 1994, for the discretionary*
24 *category: \$720,000,000 in new budget authority and*
25 *\$314,000,000 in outlays;*

1 (2) for fiscal year 1995, for the discretionary
2 category: \$2,423,000,000 in new budget authority and
3 \$2,330,000,000 in outlays;

4 (3) for fiscal year 1996, for the discretionary
5 category: \$4,267,000,000 in new budget authority and
6 \$4,184,000,000 in outlays;

7 (4) for fiscal year 1997, for the discretionary
8 category: \$6,313,000,000 in new budget authority and
9 \$6,221,000,000 in outlays; and

10 (5) for fiscal year 1998, for the discretionary
11 category: \$8,545,000,000 in new budget authority and
12 \$8,443,000,000 in outlays.
