Mr. PETERSON of Florida introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on House Administration

A BILL

To provide that each State may furnish one additional statue for placement in National Statuary Hall in the Capitol, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 That section 1814 of the Revised Statutes of the United
4 States (40 U.S.C. 187) is amended—

5 (1) in the second sentence, by striking out
6 “two” and inserting in lieu thereof “three”; and

7 (2) by adding at the end the following new sen-
8 tences: “A State may not furnish any additional
9 statue during the first 100 years after the date on
10 which it furnishes its third statue under this section.

- 1 A State shall be entitled to furnish one additional
- 2 statue in each later 100-year period.”.
