## A BILL

To amend the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 to provide an exemption from funding limitations for multijurisdictional gang task forces and child abuse response programs.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXEMPTION FROM FUNDING LIMITATION.**

4 (a) EXEMPTION FROM FUNDING LIMITATION.—Sec-  
5 tion 504(f) of title I of the Omnibus Crime Control and  
6 Safe Streets Act of 1968 (42 U.S.C. 3754(f)) is amend-  
7 ed—

8 (1) by inserting “and gang ” after “drug”; and

1           (2) by inserting “and child abuse response pro-  
2           grams established under section 501(b)(18)” after  
3           “task forces”.

4           (b) APPLICATION.—The exception regarding the time  
5           limitation under section 504(f) of the Omnibus Crime  
6           Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 shall apply to the  
7           amendments made by subsection (a) of this section irre-  
8           spective of whether grants to multijurisdictional gang task  
9           forces or child abuse response programs were awarded be-  
10          fore the date of the enactment of this Act.
