A BILL

To amend the Public Health Service Act with respect to determining the amount of a supplemental grant under the emergency relief program regarding the human immunodeficiency virus.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “HIV Emergency Sup-
5 plemental Grants Amendments of 1993”.

1 **SEC. 2. DETERMINATION OF AMOUNT OF SUPPLEMENTAL**
2 **GRANT UNDER EMERGENCY RELIEF PRO-**
3 **GRAM REGARDING HUMAN**
4 **IMMUNODEFICIENCY VIRUS.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 2603(b)(3) of the Public
6 Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 300ff-13(b)(3)) is amend-
7 ed by inserting before the period the following: “, and such
8 amount shall be based primarily on the need of the eligible
9 area for such a grant as indicated by the information pro-
10 vided in the application under paragraph (1) of such sec-
11 tion”.

12 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENT REGARDING APPLI-
13 CATIONS FOR SUPPLEMENTAL GRANTS.—Section 2605(b)
14 of the Public Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 300ff-15(b))
15 is amended—

16 (1) by redesignating paragraphs (1) through
17 (4) as paragraphs (2) through (5), respectively; and

18 (2) by inserting before paragraph (2) (as so re-
19 designated) the following paragraph:

20 “(1) the cumulative number of cases reported
21 and confirmed under section 2601(a)(1)s;”.

22 **SEC. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

23 This Act takes effect October 1, 1993, or upon the
24 date of the enactment of this Act, whichever occurs later.
