2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS FOR EX-**
4 **PANSION OF JUNIOR DUCK STAMP CON-**
5 **SERVATION PROGRAM.**

6 There are authorized to be appropriated to the Direc-
7 tor of the United States Fish and Wildlife Service
8 \$750,000 for each of fiscal years 1994, 1995, 1996, 1997,

1 and 1998, to expand implementation of the program
2 known as the “Junior Duck Stamp Conservation Pro-
3 gram” to all of the 50 States.
