Mr. SANTORUM introduced the following bill; which was referred jointly to the Committees on Government Operations and House Administration

A BILL

To require that printing for the executive and legislative branches of the Government be procured through a competitive bid process conducted by the Administrator of General Services.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. COMPETITIVE PROCUREMENT OF PRINTING**

4 **FOR THE EXECUTIVE AND LEGISLATIVE**

5 **BRANCHES OF THE GOVERNMENT.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Except as provided in subsection

7 (b), printing for the executive branch of the Government

8 and printing for the legislative branch of the Government

1 shall be procured through a competitive bid process con-
2 ducted by the Administrator of General Services.

3 (b) EXCEPTION.—Any department, agency, or other
4 entity of the executive branch or the legislative branch
5 that produces classified information may print that infor-
6 mation.

7 **SEC. 2. DEFINITION.**

8 As used in this Act, the term “classified information”
9 means information that, for reasons of national security,
10 is specifically designated by the Government, pursuant to
11 law, Executive order, or regulation, for protection against
12 unauthorized disclosure.
