Mr. SANTORUM introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Government Operations

A BILL

To limit the amount an Executive agency may obligate for office furniture and decorating in fiscal years after fiscal year 1994, and to rescind amounts available for that purpose for fiscal year 1994.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. LIMITATION ON AMOUNTS OBLIGATED FOR**
4 **FURNITURE AND DECORATING.**

5 The amount obligated by an Executive agency in a
6 fiscal year after fiscal year 1994 for office furniture and
7 decorating may not exceed the amount obligated by the
8 agency in fiscal year 1994 for furniture and decorating.

1 **SEC. 2. RESCISSION OF AMOUNTS AVAILABLE FOR OFFICE**
2 **FURNITURE AND DECORATING.**

3 Of the funds made available in appropriations Acts
4 for fiscal year 1994 to each Executive agency for purposes
5 of office furniture and decorating, 25 percent of the unob-
6 ligated balance is rescinded. The Director of the Office
7 of Management and Budget shall allocate such rescission
8 among the appropriate accounts, and shall submit to the
9 Congress a report setting forth such allocation.

10 **SEC. 3. EXECUTIVE AGENCY DEFINED.**

11 In this Act, the term "Executive agency" has the
12 meaning given that term in section 105 of title 5, United
13 States Code.
