## A BILL

To reduce the amounts appropriated to the Department of Education to increase grants to State and local educational agencies and to reduce the Federal budget deficit.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Education Bureauc-  
5 racy Reduction Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. TRANSFER OF FUNDS.**

7 (a) REDUCTION OF PERSONNEL.—For the two-year  
8 period beginning in fiscal year 1995, from the amounts

1 appropriated to the Department of Education, the Sec-  
2 retary of Education shall decrease the personnel costs at  
3 such Department by 10 percent.

4 (b) TRANSFER OF FUNDS.—(1) 90 percent of the  
5 savings from such reduction shall be transferred to local  
6 educational agencies in accordance with State aid distribu-  
7 tion formulas to such local agencies; and

8 (2) 10 percent of the savings from such reduction  
9 shall be used to reduce the Federal budget deficit.

10 (c) STATE AND LOCAL FUNDING LEVELS.—Nothing  
11 in this Act shall be construed to replace or reduce funding  
12 for education programs by the States and units of local  
13 government.
