## A BILL

To provide grants to the States to allow States to employ additional prosecutors.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. GRANT PROGRAM.**

4 (a) PROGRAM AUTHORIZED.—The Attorney General  
5 is authorized to make grants to the States to allow States  
6 to employ additional prosecutors.

7 (b) APPLICATIONS.—A State which desires to receive  
8 assistance under this section shall submit an application  
9 to the Attorney General at such time, in such manner,

1 and containing or accompanied by such information as the  
2 Attorney General may reasonably require.

3 (c) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There is  
4 authorized to be appropriated to carry out this Act  
5 \$100,000,000 for each of the fiscal years 1995 through  
6 1997.
