## A BILL

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PROHIBITION AGAINST SALE OR DELIVERY OF**  
4 **A FIREARM OR AMMUNITION TO AN INTOXI-**  
5 **CATED PERSON.**

6 Section 922(b)(1) of title 18, United States Code, is  
7 amended by inserting after “believe is”: “intoxicated from  
8 the use of alcoholic beverages or controlled substances to

1 the extent that his/her normal faculties are impaired or  
2 is”.
