A BILL

To repeal the Cuban Adjustment Act.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REPEAL OF CUBAN ADJUSTMENT ACT.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Public Law 89–732 is repealed.

5 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE; TRANSITION.—

6 (1) IN GENERAL.—Subject to paragraph (2),
7 the repeal made by subsection (a) shall take effect
8 on the date of the enactment of this Act.

9 (2) TRANSITION.—The repeal made by sub-
10 section (a) shall not apply to any alien admitted or
11 paroled into the United States before the date of the
12 enactment of this Act and who applies for adjust-

1 ment of status under the first section of Public Law
2 89-732 not later than two years after such date.
