Mr. TEJEDA introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Armed Services

A BILL

To waive certain time limitations with respect to awarding the Medal of Honor to Rudolph Salais Vela.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That, notwithstanding any time limitation contained in
4 section 3744(b) of title 10, United States Code, the Presi-
5 dent may award, and present in the name of the Congress,
6 the Medal of Honor to Rudolph Salais Vela of San Anto-
7 nio, Texas, for conspicuous acts of valor performed by him
8 while serving as a private first class in the United States
9 Army during combat operations on Okinawa during June
10 1945.
