1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 That chapter 125 of title 28, United States Code, is

4 amended—

5 (1) by adding at the end the following:

6 **“§ 1965. Notice of entry of default judgment**

7 “A district court, upon the entry of a default judg-

8 ment, shall give notice to the party against whom such

9 judgment is entered.”; and

- 1 (2) in the table of sections at the beginning, by
- 2 adding at the end the following new item:

“1965. Notice of entry of default judgment.”.
