1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DUTY-FREE ENTRIES.**

4 Subchapter II of chapter 99 is amended by inserting
5 in numerical sequence the following new heading:

“	9902.98.04	Personal effects of aliens who are participants in, or officials of, the 1994 World Rowing Championships, who are accredited members of delegations thereto, who are members of the immediate families of any of the foregoing persons, or who are their servants; equipment for use in connection with such games, and such other related articles as may be prescribed by the Secretary of the Treasury	Free	No change	Free	On or before 10/30/94	”.
