## A BILL

Entitled the "Ocean Radioactive Dumping Ban Act of 1994".

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 The Act may be cited as the "Ocean Radioactive  
5 Dumping Ban Act of 1994".

1 **SEC. 2. AMENDMENTS TO THE OCEAN DUMPING ACT.**

2 Title I of the Marine Protection, Research, and Sanc-  
3 tuaries Act of 1972 (Public Law 92-532) is amended—

4 (1) in section 3, by—

5 (A) striking paragraph (j);

6 (B) redesignating the following paragraphs  
7 accordingly; and

8 (C) altering any reference to those redesi-  
9 gnated paragraphs;

10 (2) in section 102(a), by striking “high-level”  
11 before “radioactive waste”; and

12 (3) in section 104, by striking subsection (i).

13 **SEC. 3. CLARIFICATION.**

14 *Nothing in this Act shall affect the transportation of*  
15 *dredged material for the purpose of dumping it into ocean*  
16 *waters under section 103 of the Marine Protection, Re-*  
17 *search, and Sanctuaries Act of 1972.*
