## A BILL

To provide limitations on the use of certain funds for the establishment of diplomatic relations between the United States and the territory of the former Yugoslav republic of Macedonia.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. UNITED STATES DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS WITH**  
4 **THE FORMER YUGOSLAV REPUBLIC OF MAC-**  
5 **EDONIA.**

6 No funds authorized to be appropriated to the De-  
7 partment of State may be used to pay any expense associ-  
8 ated with the establishment of diplomatic relations be-

1 tween the United States and the territory of the former  
2 Yugoslav republic of Macedonia under any official designa-  
3 tion of such territory which includes the term “Macedo-  
4 nia”. For the purposes of this section, “establishment of  
5 diplomatic relations” shall include, the establishment, up-  
6 grading, or expansion of any consulate, embassy, mission,  
7 or other post of the Department of State, and any increase  
8 in the number or level of positions at any such post.
