Mr. JOHNSTON of Florida (for himself, Mr. MURPHY, Mr. MARTINEZ, Mrs. UNSOELD, Mr. GENE GREEN of Texas, and Ms. WOOLSEY) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Education and Labor

A BILL

To amend the Job Training Partnership Act to provide counseling and guidance relating to postsecondary education options for dislocated workers.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT TO JOB TRAINING PARTNERSHIP**
4 **ACT TO PROVIDE COUNSELING AND GUID-**
5 **ANCE ON POSTSECONDARY EDUCATION OP-**
6 **TIONS FOR DISLOCATED WORKERS.**

7 Section 314 of the Job Training Partnership Act is
8 amended—

9 (1) in subsection (a)—

1 (A) in the matter preceding paragraph (1),
2 by striking “Funds” and inserting “(1)
3 Funds”;

4 (B) by redesignating paragraphs (1)
5 through (5) as subparagraphs (A) through (E),
6 respectively; and

7 (C) by adding at the end the following new
8 paragraph:

9 “(2) Funds allotted under section 302 shall be used
10 to provide counseling and guidance relating to postsecond-
11 ary education options in accordance with subsection (g).”;

12 (2) by redesignating subsections (g) and (h) as
13 subsection (h) and (i), respectively; and

14 (3) by inserting after subsection (f) the follow-
15 ing new subsection:

16 “(g) COUNSELING AND GUIDANCE ON POSTSECOND-
17 ARY EDUCATION OPTIONS.—Funds allotted under section
18 302 shall be used to provide counseling and guidance re-
19 lating to postsecondary education options for eligible dis-
20 located workers, including information on public and pri-
21 vate programs of student financial assistance available to
22 such workers for such education.”.
