3 **SECTION 1. UNIFORM EXEMPTION.**

4 Section 7(i) of the Fair Labor Standards Act of 1938  
5 (29 U.S.C. 207(i)) is amended by striking “a retail or  
6 service establishment” and inserting “an establishment”.
