3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF TIME PERIOD.**

4 The first sentence of section 302(f) of the Bank-
5 ruptcy Judges, United States Trustees, and Family Farm-

1 er Bankruptcy Act of 1986 (Public Law 99-554; 100
2 Stat. 3124) is amended by striking “1993” and inserting
3 “1998”.

4 **SEC. 2. FILING OF PLAN.**

5 Section 1221 of title 11, United States Code, is
6 amended by striking “an extension is substantially justi-
7 fied” and inserting “the need for an extension is attrib-
8 utable to circumstances for which the debtor should not
9 justly be held accountable”.

10 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF TIME PERIOD.**

11 *The first sentence of section 302(f) of the Bankruptcy*
12 *Judges, United States Trustees, and Family Farmer Bank-*
13 *ruptcy Act of 1986 (Public Law 99-554; 100 Stat. 3124)*

15 **SEC. 2. FILING OF PLAN.**

16 *Section 1221 of title 11, United States Code, is amend-*
17 *ed by striking “an extension is substantially justified” and*
18 *inserting “the need for an extension is attributable to cir-*
19 *cumstances for which the debtor should not justly be held*
20 *accountable”.*

21 **SEC. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE; APPLICATION OF AMENDMENT**

22 **MADE BY SECTION 2.**

23 (a) *EFFECTIVE DATE.*—*Except as provided in sub-*
24 *section (b), this Act and the amendments made by this Act*
25 *shall take effect on the date of the enactment of this Act.*

1 **(b) APPLICATION OF AMENDMENT MADE BY SECTION**
2 2.—*The amendment made by section 2 shall not apply with*
3 *respect to cases commenced under title 11 of the United*
4 *States Code before the date of the enactment of this Act.*
