Ms. LAMBERT introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Merchant Marine and Fisheries

A BILL

To require the Secretary of the Interior to convey the Corning National Fish Hatchery to the State of Arkansas.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Corning National Fish
5 Hatchery Conveyance Act of 1994”.

6 **SEC. 2. CONVEYANCE OF CORNING NATIONAL FISH HATCH-**
7 **ERY TO STATE OF ARKANSAS.**

8 (a) CONVEYANCE REQUIREMENT.—The Secretary of
9 the Interior shall convey to the State of Arkansas, without
10 reimbursement and by no later than December 31, 1994,

1 all right, title, and interest of the United States in and
2 to the property described in subsection (b), for use by the
3 Arkansas Game and Fish Commission as part of the State
4 of Arkansas fish culture program.

5 (b) PROPERTY DESCRIBED.—The property referred
6 to in subsection (a) is the property known as the Corning
7 National Fish Hatchery (popularly known as the William
8 H. Donham State Fish Hatchery), located one mile west
9 of Corning, Arkansas, on Arkansas State Highway 67 in
10 Clay County, Arkansas, consisting of 137.34 acres (more
11 or less), and all improvements and related personal prop-
12 erty under the control of the Secretary that is located on
13 that property, including buildings, structures, and equip-
14 ment.

15 (c) REVERSIONARY INTEREST OF UNITED STATES.—
16 If after the conveyance required by subsection (a) any of
17 the property described in subsection (b) is used for pur-
18 poses other than as described in subsection (a), all right,
19 title, and interest conveyed under this section shall revert
20 to the United States.
