## A BILL

To amend the Immigration and Nationality Act to extend the land border inspection fee program for the California southern border of the United States.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF LAND BORDER INSPECTION**  
4                       **FEE PROGRAM FOR CALIFORNIA SOUTHERN**  
5                       **BORDER OF UNITED STATES.**

6       (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 286(q)(5)(A) of the Im-  
7       migration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1356(q)(5)(A))  
8       is amended—

9               (1) by inserting “(i)” after “(5)(A)”; and

1           (2) by adding at the end the following new  
2 clause:

3           “(ii) Notwithstanding clause (i), the program author-  
4 ized in this subsection is extended until September 30,  
5 1996, with respect to—

6           “(I) the northern border of the United States  
7 (as previously provided for by Public Law 103–121  
8 (107 Stat. 1153, 1161)); and

9           “(II) the California southern border of the  
10 United States.”.

11       (b) QUARTERLY REPORT.—Section 286(q)(5)(C) of  
12 the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.  
13 1356(q)(5)(C)) is amended—

14           (1) by inserting “to the Congress” after “sub-  
15 mit”; and

16           (2) by striking “September 30, 1993” and in-  
17 serting “September 30, 1996”.
