## A BILL

To direct the Secretary of Transportation to transfer administrative jurisdiction over certain lands for inclusion in the Cape Hatteras National Seashore Recreational Area.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. TRANSFER OF OCRACOKE LIGHT STATION TO**  
4       **SECRETARY OF THE INTERIOR.**

5       The Secretary of Transportation shall transfer ad-  
6       ministrative jurisdiction over the Federal property, con-  
7       sisting of approximately 2 acres, known as the Ocracoke  
8       Light Station, to the Secretary of the Interior, subject to  
9       such reservations, terms, and conditions as may be nec-

1 essary for Coast Guard purposes. All property so trans-  
2 ferred shall be included in and administered as part of  
3 the Cape Hatteras National Seashore Recreational Area.
