A BILL

For the relief of Lester J. Reschly.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CLASSIFICATION OF TRANSFER FOR PURPOSES**

4 **OF RELOCATION EXPENSES.**

5 The transfer of Lester J. Reschly from Ottumwa,
6 Iowa to Columbia, Missouri in March 1992, by the Food
7 Safety and Inspection Service of the Department of Agri-
8 culture shall be considered to be a transfer in the interest
9 of the Government from one official duty station to an-
10 other for permanent duty, for the purpose of entitling Les-
11 ter J. Reschly to reimbursement, under sections 5724 and
12 5724a of title 5, United States Code, for the unreimbursed

1 expenses associated with the transfer and relocation of
2 Lester J. Reschly from Medford, Oregon to Ottumwa,
3 Iowa in October 1991, and from Ottumwa, Iowa to Colum-
4 bia, Missouri in March 1992, while employed by the Food
5 Safety and Inspection Service of the Department of Agri-
6 culture.
